



## CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the society is the **Central Okanagan Hospice Association**.
2. The purpose(s) of the Society is (are)
  - a) To be of service to the community through the development of programs based on the principles set out by Doctor Cicley Saunders of St. Christopher's Hospice, London, England to support the grieving and dying.
  - b) To organize and train volunteers for the various programs offered.
  - c) To work towards establishing a free standing Hospice House in coordination with government and private organizations and partners
  - d) To provide leadership and to stimulate citizen participation in the study, assessment and improvement of Hospice and bereavement care in the community.
  - e) To increase public understanding of the services provided by the Society.
  - f) To receive funds or grants and to administer the same consistent with the purposes of the Society.
  - g) To work in conjunction and cooperation with the government and private organizations which share common interests and goals as the Society.
3. Upon dissolution of the Society, any assets of the Society remaining after satisfaction of its debts, liabilities and the cost of dissolution shall not be distributed among the members, but shall be given to one or more charitable institutions appointed by the Directors.
