- Falcon Ridge Farms is someone's private home; please stay only in designated event areas.
- Dress for weather as this is an outdoor event; please also bring lawn chairs/blankets for seating.
- You may be photographed while at the event.

Location:

- Falcon Ridge Farms is at 579 Rifle Road in Kelowna, BC; this is in the Glenmore neighbourhood of Kelowna and very near The Greenery.
- The entrance to Falcon Ridge Farms will be marked by The Butterfly Effect signage; please turn off Rifle Road and follow the access road to the parking area.

Parking:

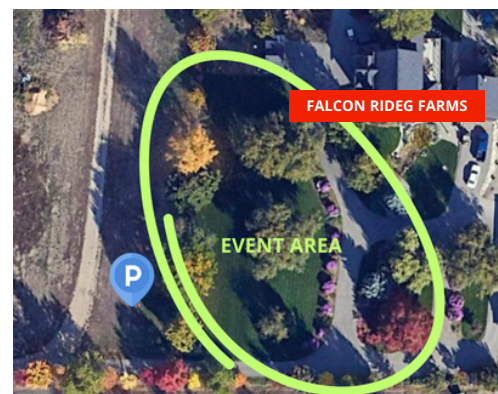
- On-site parking is available.
- Accessible parking available on a limited basis; please ensure your accessible parking tag is clearly visible. 

Transport to Event Area:

- The Event Area is next to parking; golf carts will be available to transport those with mobility challenges who request a ride.
- Thank you for being patient while our volunteers shuttle guests to and from the event area.

Arrival & Check-In:

- Upon arrival, please go to the Registration Desk.
- Golf carts will be available to transport those with mobility challenges to the event area; your patience is appreciated.
- At the Registration Desk, please present your confirmation email which shows the number of butterflies you will receive.
- If you have not received your confirmation email, please contact Kris Johnson, Events and Marketing Manager by email kimberly@hospicecoha.org or by calling 250.763.5511 prior to Friday, June 19.
- Butterflies are registered under the name of the purchaser.
- Once registered, attendees will be given their tickets which represents the number of butterflies to be picked up.



On-Site Activities:

- Please enjoy the live music, the children's activities, the light refreshments, and feel free to write your own messages for our Memory Wall prior to the butterfly release.
- The "official program" will get underway at approx. 11:15AM.

Butterfly Release:

- Shortly after 11:30AM, attendees will be asked to pick up their butterflies at the Butterfly Pick Up Station by exchanging their tickets for the live butterflies.
- Attendees can then release their butterflies on their own or with their loved ones. The event concludes after the butterflies release.

Tax Receipts:

- Tax receipts are not issued for the purchase of butterflies, only for donations (per CRA regulations).

Donations:

- Donations can be made to this event, and donors receive tax receipts for contributions of \$20 and up.

No Refund Policy:

- All butterfly purchases are non-refundable. In the event of adverse weather conditions, including but not limited to extreme rain, wind, or extreme heat, or unforeseen circumstances such as wildfires that prevent the release of butterflies from taking place, no refunds will be issued. Due to the nature of this release, there will be no alternative date set for the event. In this case, COHA is responsible for releasing the butterflies into their natural landscape.

Butterfly Release Requirement:

- The butterflies will be released at the time shown in our marketing and communications. To ensure the butterflies' welfare, the timed release is significant to our conservation efforts.
- If a purchased butterfly is not picked up on time, COHA is responsible for releasing the butterflies into their natural landscape.
